

**LESSON GOALS:**

- Help students review their Citizen, Academic and Career goals.
- Beginning SLC preparation

ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS:

- How do I prepare for my SLC?

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- **Students' Citizen, Academic and Career goals** (*from earlier lessons*)
- **SLC video** (*from your lead advisor*)
- **SLC Rubric** (*Next page of this lesson*)

CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES:

1. **Collect Annual Academic Goals.** Make sure the parents have signed them.
2. **Discuss students' Citizenship, Academic and Career Goals.** Over the last several lessons, your students have been asked to develop goals for (1) becoming a leader at school and participating in the life of the community; (2) preparing academically for graduation; and (3) developing specific plans to apply to postsecondary institutions. Discuss these goals with them. Have they taken any steps to achieve their goals? What might help them achieve their goals?
3. **Review Goals for Student-Led Conference (SLC).** Using the goals you set in the last sessions, have students look at the rubric for the SLC and relate these goals to their conference. They should be thinking about how they are going to relate these goals in their presentation.
4. **Watch a SLC.** You will get a copy of one of last year's senior's SLC. Please hand out a **Rubric** and have the kids grade the student as the video plays. Discuss grading and answer questions after the video if time.
