

**LESSON GOALS:**

- Help students review the status of their postsecondary applications.

ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS:

- What will I do after high school?
- How can I plan?

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Students' portfolios
- **High School and Beyond Plan** handout

CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES:

1. **Review students' plans and their progress with postsecondary applications.** How are your students doing? Have they completed needed college entrance exams? Have they completed their college applications? Have they applied for scholarships or other forms of financial aid? Discuss students' progress. You may want to give them time during this lesson to organize their materials or conduct research for postsecondary plans if needed.
2. **Counselors visit.** Discuss and answer questions to post secondary and employment options.
3. **Begin organizing portfolios.** If time, students can continue to organize portfolios into 3 categories (Academic, Career, Personal/social) for SLC.
4. **Rationale Writing** (if extra time).
5. **High School and Beyond Plan.** If time allows, handout the **High School and Beyond Plan Requirements** page and read over it with students. This will not be due for 2-3 Nav. sessions. (next page of this lesson).
6. **Resume** will be needed next week for revision, remind students to bring it with them.

STUDENT PRODUCTS:

- Students should begin organizing their portfolios for their final Student-led Conferences or Senior Presentations.
