Notes

- (1) Entrance into 4-year universities in Washington State will require either a math credit or a math-based science course in the senior year.
- (2) Three credits beyond the general studies requirements must be linked to the student's High School & Beyond Plan. One of these credits must be an occupational education credit. These three credits are known as a student's Career Concentration.
- (3) One PE (Fitness) credit can be waived if participating in two or more sports over the course of grades 9-12.
- (4) Entrance into most 4-year universities requires two years of a second language for acceptance.
- (5) Students seeking to participate in band, choir, or drama all four years of high school may be required to take on-line courses and/or seek PE (Fitness) waivers to create credit capacity. Please see counselor for details.
- (6) Students will be required to complete their High School & Beyond Plan and Culminating Project as part of their graduation requirements.
