LESSON: 18

THEME: MAKING THE TRANSITION



LESSON GOALS:

- Review students' experiences in 9th grade.
- Help students prepare for next year.
- Celebrate!

ESSENTIAL QUESTIONS:

- What do I want to do next year?
- How can I succeed?

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- **Students' Portfolios** (*students may want to review their work from the year*)
- Nav. 101 and SLC Reflection

CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES:

1. **Review freshman year.** Look back at the year that's nearly over. Discuss with students what they thought was best – and worst – about their first year in high school. Did advisory help? Why or why not? What advice would they give to incoming freshmen about succeeding in high school? What did they learn this year? Where did they make progress? Teacher should check off student portfolios one last time.
2. **Plan for next year.** What challenges and opportunities will next year bring? Discuss what your students can expect next year when they are sophomores. Are there clubs, activities, or leadership positions they can take on? Are there activities they didn't pursue this year that they want to try next year? What about their courses? How many will be taking advanced or honors courses?
3. **Reflection.** Hand out Nav. 101 and SLC Reflection Questions. Have students complete handout and return to advisor.
4. **Celebrate.** You might want to celebrate with pizza or other treats.

STUDENT PRODUCTS:

- **Completed portfolios.** Each student's portfolio should be stored at school until next fall.
