Mandatory Policies EL-18

The Board understands that certain legislative bodies may require the Board to adopt policies that would be considered operational and therefore delegated to the Superintendent, under Policy Governance. In order to satisfy both these regulatory requirements and the Board's desire to delegate operational issues to the Superintendent, the Board adopts this policy.

Accordingly, the Superintendent shall not fail to:

- 1. Create and implement District Policies and Procedures as required by local, state and federal legislation pertaining to the areas:
 - a. Title I Parent Involvement.
 - b. Health and Nutrition.
 - c. Use of pesticides.
 - d. Alternative Learning Experience Programs.
 - e. Other policies as required.
- 2. Present the proposed policy to the board for review, before implementation.
- 3. Follow all local, state and federal laws in the operation of the district in the absence of approved District Policies and Procedures.
