Organization of Board of Directors

GP-2-E5

At the first regular meeting following election of directors, the board shall elect from among its members a chair, a vice chair, and a legislative representative to serve one-year terms. Officers shall not be elected following the appointment of a board member to fill a vacancy unless a majority of the board is appointed. If a board member is unable to continue to serve as an officer, a replacement shall be elected immediately. In the absence of both the chair and the vice chair, the board shall elect a chair pro tempore who shall perform the functions of the chair during the latter's absence.

- 1. The normal order of business shall be modified by considering the following matters after the approval of the minutes of the previous meeting:
 - a. Welcome and instruction of newly-elected board members by the chair.
 - b. Call for nominations for chair to serve during the ensuing year.
 - c. Election of a chair (roll call vote).
 - d. Assumption of office by the new chair
 - e. Call for nominations for vice chair to serve during the ensuing year.
 - f. Election of a vice chair (roll call vote).
 - g. Call for nominations for legislative representative to serve during the ensuing year.
 - h. Election of legislative representative.
