- Students are required to take 3 years of Social Studies. We recommend you take these during 10th, 11th, and 12th grade.
- US History (sophomore course) may be taken in 9th grade. It is recommended that students have at least a 3.0 GPA or higher to take this course in 9th grade.
- Please note: US History curriculum includes mature content including Civil War/Slavery and World War II/Holocaust.
